Professor/Associate Professor of Nutritional Sciences

The Faculty of Health Sciences would like to invite applications from qualified candidates for the position of Professor/Associate Professor for a fixed period of ten months. An extension of the contract is possible. The position is to begin October 2020.

The position

This Professor/Associate Professor position is focused on teaching in area of nutrition in physical activity and nutrition of athletes, but also other related topics are eligible for support. The candidate will also have the possibility of supporting, collaborating or taking part in research projects conducted in our university in dietary science. In addition, we provide access to complementary research infrastructure via our close collaborators in biochemistry, physiology and neurophysiology, as well as psychology.

The candidate

You are expected to have a clear teaching and research profile in dietary science linked to studying nutrition in view of positive health impacts and applications, preferably in sport or physical activity. This position requires teaching these selected issues in the area of nutrition in a modern way, based on the latest knowledge and own research. Teaching courses at Bachelor and Master level is also expected. Collaboration and exchange of knowledge with industry and national advisory institutions is seen as a natural part of the position.

Qualifications

The following qualifications are required:

- Hold a PhD degree in Dietary/Food Science
- Documented research experience in Dietary/Food Science
- Documented experience in writing and securing grant applications from both industrial and public sources
- Documented experience in academic project leadership
- Documented experience in co-supervision/supervision of Bachelor/Masters/PhD students
- Documented teaching experience and demonstrated ability to develop relevant educational materials

Department of Food and Nutrition

The Department of Food and Nutrition is part of the Faculty of Health Sciences at AWF in Poznan, and is involved in research in areas such as nutrition and nutritional status of athletes as well as nutrition in metabolic diseases. The Department currently employs 8 full time academic staff.

Employment and place of work

The place of work is ul. Królowej Jadwigi 27/39, Poznan, Poland, and the area of employment is Poznan University of Physical Education and its relevant departments.

Application procedure

Candidates will be shortlisted based on an assessment of their relevance in view of the requirements of the job posting. All applicants will be notified within 6 weeks whether or not their application had been sent to an expert assessment committee for evaluation. Once the recruitment process is completed, a final letter of rejection is sent to deselected applicants, including the main considerations emphasised in the selection process.

Formalities and salary range

The application must be in English and include your curriculum vitae, degree certificate, complete list of publications, statement of future research plans and information about research activities, teaching portfolio, and verified information on previous teaching experience (if any).

The salary, based on competence and experience, is about 2,000 euros per month.
