Information on the recruitment procedure:	<p><b>The competition is open to individuals who meet the conditions specified in Article 113 of the Act of 20 July 2018, the Law on Higher Education and Science (i.e. Journal of Laws of 2023, item 742, as amended).</b></p> <p>Applications will be reviewed by a Competition Committee appointed by the UW Rector. The Committee may invite selected candidates for an interview. The competition will be resolved no later than on 30 November 2023. The competition is the first stage of the procedure specified in the UW Statute and applicable in the process of employing for an academic staff position, and its positive resolution constitutes the basis for undertaking further proceedings. Candidates will be informed of the outcome of the competition by email.</p>
