- 5. Statement on legal capacity, clean criminal record and exercising full civil rights.
- 6. Statement on relationship with immediate superior.
- 7. Signed statement of consent to process personal data for recruitment purposes.

- 1. Habilitation degree in the discipline of management and quality sciences or in a related discipline.
- 2. Availability and commitment to the Institute, Department and University.
- 3. In academic achievement, publications on civil aviation.
- 4. Experience in conducting scientific research and grants in the field of management or safety.
- 5. Experience in teaching at a university.
- 6. Communicative knowledge of English.
