- 2) experience of over 5 years in instrumental analysis and in particular the analysis of trace elements (Atomic Adsorption Spectrometry method, HPLC method, UV-VIS Spectrophotometry, electrochemical methods),
- 3) experience in qualitative and quantitative analysis,
- 4) sample preparation (knowledge of sample preparation procedures for analysis - organic, environmental, technical and technological samples and biological material (animal, plant, human tissues), analysis of samples with a complex matrix, ability to isolate and pre-concentrate trace components, sample mineralization),
- 5) ability to plan and conduct experiments,
- 6) predispositions to manage scientific projects,
- 7) proficient knowledge of advanced statistical tools, in particular chemometric methods,
- 8) proven scientific achievements from national and international conferences,
- 9) supervisor of master's theses and auxiliary supervisor of doctoral theses,
- 10) scientific publications in a given discipline in international journals (minimum number 30),
- 11) total impact factor of at least 100,
- 12) knowledge of pharmacopoeial issues and analytical procedures,
- 13) knowledge of conducting research under controlled *in vitro* conditions,
- 14) research and development activities with growing companies,
- 15) knowledge of the English language at the B-2 level or higher,
- 16) exemplary ethical attitude (in compliance with www.agh.edu.pl/o-agh/dokumenty/inne/kodeks-etyczny-agh),
- 17) scientific achievements and organizational experience,
- 18) active participation in scientific conferences and symposia.
