### REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) PhD in Earth and related environmental sciences in the Field of Natural Sciences,
- 2) knowledge of issues related to renewable energy sources, in particular in the field of geothermal energy, including modeling of geothermal reservoirs,
- 3) experience in implementing scientific and research projects and commercial projects,
- 4) experience in teaching, in particular in the area related to renewable energy sources, thermodynamics and energy,
- 5) good knowledge of computer programs such as: Petrel, ArcGIS, Corel package, Autocad, Origin Pro or similar,
- 6) organizational achievements and active participation in scientific conferences and symposia,
- 7) documented scientific achievements in the form of authorship and co-authorship of scientific publications on national and international scale (Hirsh Index at least 3 according to WoS and required publications in journals from the Journal Citation Reports- JCR list),
- 8) documented knowledge of English language skills of at least C-1 level,
- 9) knowledge of the Polish language required (candidates who are not Polish citizens should attach a certificate of Polish language knowledge at least C-1 level).

### DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

- 1) application, CV, personal questionnaire,
- 2) a copy of the doctoral diploma,
- 3) information about the research, organizational and teaching activities,
- 4) list of publications,
- 5) research plans and scientific and teaching interests, along with an indication of how they will contribute to the further development of the Department and Faculty,
- 6) document confirming knowledge of English at least C-1 level,
- 7) certificates confirming the knowledge of computer programs (optional),
- 8) certificate of Polish language knowledge at least C-1 level (candidates who are not Polish citizens).
