announces

an open competition for the position of

The competition shall be entered only by individuals fulfilling the conditions laid down in article 113 of the Act of 20 July 2018 of the Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws from 2021, item 478).

Candidates entering the competition are requested to send the documents listed below to the following address:

or submit the documents in sealed envelope described as above at the office of registration located at the University Pass Office, building 52.

The required documents:

1. Application to Rector for employment at the War Studies University.
2. CV presenting professional experience and teaching experience, including distance learning.
3. Certified copy of the diploma confirming holding a university degree (second-cycle studies) in English Philology or Applied Linguistics.
4. Statement confirming conducting English language classes at a university (optional)
5. Statement confirming conducting departmental courses preparing for English language examinations in accordance with the NATO STANAG 6001 agreement (optional)
6. Statement confirming that the War Studies University will be the place of one's primary employment.
7. Statement on legal capacity, clean criminal record and exercising full civil rights.
8. Statement on relationship with immediate superior.
9. Signed statement of consent to process personal data for recruitment purposes.
10. In case of persons who are not Polish citizens, permission to work in Poland is required as well as knowledge of the Polish language at a minimum level of B1, in accordance with CEFR.

The competition will be adjudicated by the selection board.

Documents should be submitted **by 18 June 2024.**

The competition shall be adjudicated **on 26 June 2024.**

INSTRUCTION:

2. Adjudication of the competition is not tantamount to entering into employment relationship with War Studies University, but it shall be recommendation for Rector in this respect. Final decision on employment shall be made by Rector.
