- 3) documented knowledge of English language at minimum level of B-2,
- 4) knowledge of construction projects engineering (technology and organisation of construction works, cost estimating, construction project management, logistics in construction, Occupational Health and Safety),
- 5) willingness to conduct classes in Polish and English in the field of technology and organisation of construction work, construction economics and construction project management, including the use of distance learning techniques,
- 6) willingness to conduct research and apply for research grants,
- 7) conscientiousness and teamwork skills,
- 8) active participation in scientific conferences and symposia,
- 9) documented teaching, scientific and organizational achievements,
- 10) possessing an exemplary ethical attitude (in accordance with [www.agh.edu.pl](http://www.agh.edu.pl) – documents – „Ethical Code“).
