**At the Academy of Art in Szczecin, classes are conducted in Polish and take place on-site. The competition may be entered by persons who meet the requirements specified in Art. 113 of the Act of July 20, 2018 - Law on higher education and science (uniform text, Journal of Laws of 2023, item 742, as amended) and meet the following qualification criteria:**

- Master's degree in Humanities, - History of Art, History and Theory of Design
- documented activity in the area of research and criticism of art and design
- experience in working with students
- documented cooperation with cultural and art institutions
- interest in scientific development
- curatorial experience in organizing contemporary art exhibitions

**Required documents:**

- application for participation in the competition,
- professional CV and personal questionnaire,
- copy of master's/doctoral diploma,
- description of artistic achievements supported by documentation,
- a statement that the Academy of Art in Szczecin will be the primary place of work,
- declaration pursuant to Art. 113 of the Law on Higher Education and Science,
- any additional information (in the form of documents or publications that may be important in assessing additional skills related to the outcome of the competition).
- in the case of foreigners applying for employment under the competition, knowledge of Polish is required
