The Academy of Art in Szczecin announces a competition open for the position LECTURER

in the Interfaculty Department of Computer Games and Virtual Reality

The competition may be entered by persons who meet the requirements provided for in Art. 113 of the Act of July 20, 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science (consolidated text, Journal of Laws of 2020, item 85, as amended) and meet the following qualification criteria:

Necessary qualifications:

- holding a master's degree and education in the field of law and/or administration,
- having the qualifications of a mediator in the field of civil and/or commercial law and/or labor law,
- documented experience in the field of legal services for entities operating in the computer games and/or virtual reality industry.

Additional qualifications to be assessed:

- teaching experience related to the use of the above skills,
- teaching achievements related to the use of the above skills.

Required documents:

- application for participation in the competition,
- professional CV and personal questionnaire,
- a copy of graduation diplomas,
- a statement that the Academy of Art in Szczecin will be the primary place of work,
- a declaration pursuant to Art. 113 of the Law on Higher Education and Science,
- any additional information (in the form of documents or publications that may be of importance in the assessment of additional skills related to the award of the competition),
