DESCRIPTION (topics, expectations, comments, requirements):

Requirements:

- 1) at least Master of Science degree in the field of exact and natural sciences, in the discipline of Earth and environmental sciences or a related field,
- 2) documented experience in exploration and engineering geophysics and petroleum geology, supported by publications and participation in research or commercial projects,
- 3) knowledge of geophysical methods used in geological structure recognition, both at regional and local scales, including seismic, electromagnetic, and gravity methods,
- 4) ability to analyse and interpret geophysical data using specialized software, confirmed by participation in projects or relevant certificates/trainings,
- 5) experience in teaching activities,
- 6) documented knowledge of English at least at B-2 level,
- 7) documented scientific achievements in the form of participation in scientific conferences and authorship/co-authorship of scientific publications of national and international scope in the required specialized topics (points 2, 3, and 4),
- 8) knowledge of the Polish language required (candidates who are not Polish citizens should attach a certificate of knowledge of the Polish language at the level of at least C-1).

To be considered a candidate you must meet the following requirements set out in the Act:

- 1) you hold the qualifications defined in the Act,
- 2) you have full capacity for juridical acts,
- 3) you have not been convicted for an intentional offence,
- 4) you enjoy full public rights.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

- 1) application letter, CV, personal questionnaire,
- 2) copy of the master's diploma,
- 3) information about previous scientific and teaching activities,
- 4) list of publications,
- 5) documents confirming English language proficiency at least at B2 level,
- 6) certificates confirming knowledge of computer software,
- 7) certificate of Polish language proficiency at least at C-1 level (for candidates who are not Polish citizens).
