The successful candidate will be employed in the project "Paths to Polysemy: Integrating Approaches to the Role of Polysemy in the Evolutionary Dynamics of Language." (PI: Dr Michael Pleyer).

The goal of the project is to combine cognitive and experimental approaches, especially in the domain of experimental semiotics, to understand how polysemy plays a role in the cultural evolution of language. A special focus of the project lies on cross-cultural differences in the evolutionary paths of polysemy and meaning extension.
