- 4) significant scientific achievements confirmed by scientific publications in the field of numerical modelling, materials testing and acoustic emission, including publications in journals with an Impact Factor (JCR list), and at least two top-ranked publications (200 pts. acc. to MNiSW),
- 5) didactic and organizational achievements,
- 6) ability to collaborate and work in research teams,
- 7) strong motivation to work and pursue scientific questions, creativity, and analytical thinking.

A person may become a candidate if they meet the following requirements set forth in the Law on Higher Education:

- 1) has the qualifications specified in the Law,
- 2) has full legal capacity,
- 3) has not been punished by a final court judgment for an intentional crime,
- 4) enjoys full public rights.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- 3) copy of the PhD diploma and copies of certificates of other qualifications,
- 4) list of scientific achievements (published papers, and conference presentations),
- 5) list of research and research and development projects,
- 6) reference on the past scientific and didactic activities,
- 7) document confirming participation in a didactic excellence course.
