announces

an open competition for the position of

english language lector (replacement employment contract)

in Foreign Languages Centre

in the group of **didactic** employees

In order to be eligible to apply, candidates must meet the conditions specified in Article 113 of the Act of 20 July 2018, Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws from 2021, item 478).

Candidates entering the competition are requested to send the documents listed below to the following address:

or submit the documents in a sealed envelope with the description as above at the reception point of the War Studies University located in the Pass Office, building no. 52.

The required documents:

1. An application to Rector for employment at the War Studies University.
2. A CV outlining professional experience, teaching experience, including remote teaching.
3. A certified copy of a diploma that confirms holding a university degree (second-cycle studies) in English philology or applied linguistics.
4. A confirmation that the candidate has conducted English language classes at a university (optional).
5. A confirmation that the candidate has conducted departmental courses preparing for English language examinations in accordance with the NATO STANAG 6001 agreement (optional).
6. A declaration confirming that the War Studies University will be the candidate's primary place of employment.
7. A declaration regarding legal capacity, clean criminal record and exercising full civil rights.
8. A declaration concerning kinship with immediate superior.
9. A signed declaration of consent to process personal data for recruitment purposes.

10. For individuals who are not Polish citizens, a work permit for Poland and knowledge of the Polish language at a minimum B2 level according to CEFR standards are required.

The competition will be adjudicated by a selection committee.

Application deadline: 19.08.2025.

The competition shall be adjudicated on 29.08.2025.
