- 3) knowledge of the following topics confirmed by publications, theses, projects or speeches: (1) Databases in Biology and Medicine, and (2) Digital Image Processing (medical),
- 4) certificate Cisco IT Essentials 5.0 Certificate,
- 5) professional experience in conducting didactic classes in the area of computer and database programming,
- 6) knowledge of English at least at B-2 level,
- 7) confirmed active participation in the student scientific movement or documented scientific achievements resulting from higher education, doctoral studies, doctoral studies or professional work.

A candidate may be a person who meets the following requirements specified in the Act on Higher Education:

- 1) has the qualifications specified in the Act,
- 2) has full legal capacity,
- 3) has not been punished by a final court judgement for an intentional crime,
- 4) enjoys full public rights.

- 5) an opinion confirming the candidate's predispositions for research and teaching.
