## II. Job offer description

Work as an ASSISTANT PROFESSOR, a research and teaching employee (included in the number of researchers [N], who, in addition to teaching, implements his/her own artistic projects and for whom Adam Mickiewicz University will be the PRIMARY place of work.  
In terms of skills and competences, the teacher will conduct classes in percussion, instrumental improvisation, the history of jazz and stage music, and drumming methodology.

## III. Requirements and qualifications

The competition is open to individuals who meet the requirements specified in Article 113 of the Law on Higher Education and Science of 20 July 2018 (Journal of Laws of 2024, item 1571, Article 113 as amended) and who meet the following requirements:

1. Education and experience in the musical arts discipline, specializing in percussion
2. Possession of a doctoral degree (musical arts/percussion)
3. proven record of artistic achievement and plans for academic development
4. independence, communication skills,
5. an aptitude for teaching.

## V. Required research, teaching or mixed experience
