Description (subject, requirements, comments)	<p>The responsibilities of the Assistant will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• conducting classes for students of the following degree programmes: Animal Science, Veterinary Inspection, Veterinary Medicine, Animal Physiotherapy and Animal Care, in the fields of animal anatomy and topographical animal anatomy;• carrying out organizational activities for the benefit of the Department, Faculty, and University;• performing administrative tasks related to the teaching process;• preparing popular science publications;• conducting scientific activities within the discipline of Veterinary Medicine, including carrying out research, preparing applications for research and educational project funding, and authoring scientific publications. <p>The candidate is expected to demonstrate:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• aptitude for working with students;• availability, commitment, and creativity;• a high standard of professional conduct and interpersonal skills;• the ability to work independently on assigned tasks as well as collaboratively within a team;• a commitment to continuous professional development and the enhancement of professional competencies.

Information Clause for Employee Candidates

Pursuant to Art. 13 of the general regulation on the protection of personal data of 27 April 2016 (Journal of Laws UE L 119 of 04/05/2016) on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / WE - general regulation on data protection (Journal of Laws UE L 119/1 of 04/05/2016), Bydgoszcz University of Science and Technology informs that:

3. your personal data will be processed:
 1. for the purposes of the currently announced recruitment - pursuant to Art. 6 sec. 1 letter b of the general regulation on data protection of April 27, 2016 and the Labor Code of June 26, 1974 in order to conclude a contract,
 2. for future recruitments if you give your consent pursuant to Art. 6 sec. 1 letter a of the regulation, expressed in writing for the period specified in the consent declaration,
4. your personal data, in the event of failure to conclude the contract, will be kept for a period of up to 3 months or the time specified in the consent statement,
5. the recipients of your personal data will only be entities authorized to obtain personal data on the basis of legal provisions and entities cooperating in the recruitment process, your data will not be transferred to a third country, except for cases resulting from your express request,
6. you have the right to request the administrator to access your personal data, the right to request rectification, deletion or limitation of processing, the right to object to the processing, the right to transfer data, and if consent is granted, the right to withdraw it in any time,
