Applications to the open call may be submitted by those who meet the conditions defined in Art. 113 of the Act of 20 July 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 85, as amended).

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- conducting research in the discipline of literary studies in the scope of German-speaking literature and translation studies,
- fulfilling the role of the leader of the research team,
- conducting didactic classes on 1st cycle and 2nd cycle studies for the German Studies programme (210 didactic hours),
- participation in the organizational works for the Faculty of Humanities and the University of Silesia in accordance with the Regulations of the University of Silesia,

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- master degree in German Studies,
- PhD degree in Humanities in the discipline of literary studies granted during the five years prior to employment,
- minimum 4 years of experience in conducting research in the discipline of literary studies,
- knowledge of research methods including the typology of narrative situations, narrative concepts, focalization, spatial form theories and biographical method,
- ability to write publications in Polish and German,
- articles concerning German-speaking Upper Silesian literature of the XX Century published in scientific journals indexed in scientific databases, including minimum one article published in the journal that appears on the list of scientific journals and reviewed materials from international conferences of The Minister of Science and Education,
- publications of chapters on the German-speaking Upper Silesian literature of the XX Century in monographs, one of which was published by a publisher included in the Ministry's list of publishers,
- presentation of the plan for candidate's monograph on the above subject,
- scientific development plan for 2 years,
- minimum 3 years of experience in conducting classes in the higher education facility on the 1st cycle and 2nd cycle studies, especially in the scope of practical German language teaching and the history of German-speaking literature,
- the knowledge of English/other language that allows for conducting classes,
- knowledge of Polish that allows for conducting classes (in the case of foreign candidates),
- experience in the scope of using tools and methods of distance learning,
- organizational achievements in didactics,
- proposals for development projects for students as a part of students scientific associations and science festivals,
- proposals for candidate's self-development in the scope of didactic and scientific competences

In the case of foreign candidates, whose diplomas granting scientific degrees require nostrification according to the Polish law, can be employed only after fulfilling nostrification procedures.
