RESPONSIBILITIES:

- conducting interdiciplinary scientific research in the scope of the literary Polish-German translation of specialist texts,
- publishing the results of the research in the scope of literary translation or specialist translation in the indexed journals,
- preparation of the application for grant,
- fulfilling the role of the leader of the research team,
- conducting classes on 1st cycle and 2nd cycle studies for the German Studies programme in the amount of 210 didactic hours.
- participation in the organizational works for the Faculty of Humanities and the University of Silesia in accordance with the Regulations of the University of Silesia

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- master degree in German Studies or Slavonic Studies,
- PhD degree in Humanities in the discipline of Linguistics or Literary Studies granted not earlier than 5 years prior to the planned employment,
- pedagogical training in teaching German,
- knowledge of other conference languages,
- minimum 4 years of experience in conducting research in the discipline of linguistics or literary
- scientific achievement in the discipline of linguistics or literary studies in the area of research connected with translation of non-literary, specialist and literary texts, indexed in the scientific databases e.g. Scopus or Web of Science),
- documented experience in managing or acquiring research projects/grants, especially the ERC projects/grants, ability to write publications in Polish and German,
- articles on non-literary, specialist and lierary translations published in scientific journals indexed in
- scientific databases, including minimum one article published in the journal that appears on the list of scientific journals and reviewed materials from international conferences of The Minister of Science and Education,
- publications of chapters on translation of non-literary, specialist and literary texts in monographs, including minimum one which was published by a publisher included in the Ministry's list of publishers
- preparation of the plan for candidate's monograph concerning the above subjects, self-development plan for two years,
- minimum 3 years of experience in conducting classes in the higher education facility on the 1st cycle and 2nd cycle studies, especially in the scope of foreign language teaching, the knowledge of German and one other language that allows for conducting classes.
