RESPONSIBILITIES:

- formulating research hypotheses and planning experiments in the scope of project tasks,
- conducing results analyses, analysis and interpretation of data, preparation of reports,
- presenting and publishing research results,
- carrying out other tasks for the project defined by the project leader, connected with research activity.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- PhD degree in the discipline of earth sciences, chemistry or related field,
- fluent English (minimum B2 or C1),
- experience in the GC-MS and especially HP-LC-MS measurements (will be of advantage),
- active participation in scientific life (conferences, workshops, international cooperation),
- documented participation in works being a part of research projects,
- documented experience in preparation of manuscripts for the international scientific journals,
- documented scientific achievements published in the journals with the high IF factor,
- experience in conducting research in earth sciences, environmental sciences or chemistry,
- documented scientific achievements in the discipline of earth sciences, environmental sciences or in the related disciplines (e.g. indexed in *Scopus* and *Web of Science*),
- experience in laboratory work
- experience in managing/realization/acquiring research projects/grants,
- ability to write scientific publications in English, and documented works of which the candidate is the leading author or a correspondence author,
- ability to use statistical methods (will be of advantage)
