- documented fluent knowledge of English at a level of at least B-2,
- knowledge of the Polish language required (candidates who are not Polish citizens should attach a certificate of knowledge of the Polish language at a level of at least C-1),

SIGNIFICANT FACTORS INFLUENCING THE EVALUATION OF THE CANDIDATE WILL BE:

- knowledge on chemical analytical techniques for the analysis of solids and liquids as well as their practical use (in particular, atomic absorption spectroscopy, Fourier infrared spectroscopy, Raman spectroscopy, UV-Vis spectrophotometry),
- the ability to interpret the results of phase and structural analysis of solid materials (in particular X-ray diffraction, photoelectron spectroscopy),
- experience in laboratory works,
- national and international awards for research or student activities,
- knowledge and ability to use software for the visualization and presentation of research results, e.g. Grapher Golden Software, Origin, etc.
