The required documents:

1. Application to Rector-Commandant for employment at the War Studies University.
2. Self-presentation on professional career and teaching experience, including distance learning.
3. Certified copy of the diploma confirming obtaining the professional title of MA in English Philology.
4. Certificate confirming conducting English language classes at university.
5. Certificate confirming running departmental training courses aimed at preparing candidates for English exams in accordance with NATO STANAG 6001 agreement.
6. Statement confirming performing specialist translations from English into Polish and from Polish into English.
7. Statement confirming that the War Studies University will be the place of one's primary employment.
8. Statement on legal capacity, clean criminal record and exercising full civil rights.
9. Statement on relationship with immediate superior.
10. Signed statement of consent to process personal data for recruitment purposes.

The competition will be adjudicated by the selection board.

Documents should be submitted by 20 December 2021.

The competition shall be adjudicated on 21 December 2021.
