We are offering a position of an adjunct in a group of research workers in the Space Technology Centre, a unit of the AGH University of Science and Technology within the Beyond UNIVERSEH project

FIELD: Mechanical engineering, Space technology

The Candidate should meet the conditions defined on the Act of 20 July 2018 – On Higher Education and Science (i.e. the 2018 Journal of Laws, item 1668 with latter amendments). The work conditions and salary are specified in the Act.

The Beyond UNIVERSEH project, awarded under the H2020 program, brings together European partners with a common goal: to develop best practices in space research in the context of its connections with other fields of science, as well as social challenges.

Adjunct envisaged to be employed on this project will participate in the work of the team, with particular emphasis on conducting research and organizing international research teams together with project partners. He/She will also actively contribute to the development of an innovation strategy and protection of intellectual property generated through joint projects of project partners.

Requirements:

- Ability to conduct scientific research in the field of space technologies
- Ability to work in an international research team
- Ability to organize international research teams
- Having a minimum doctoral degree obtained within 4 years prior to submitting the application for the position of adjunct

- Fluency in spoken and written English (knowledge of a second language will be an advantage - German, French, Swedish)
- Publication of at least 2 scientific papers in journals from the JCR list
- Active participation in conferences and symposia

We offer a part time employment (0,5 FTE) for a period of 30 months. Envisaged starting date is March 1, 2022 with August 31, 2024 as end date.

The Candidate must meet the following requirements defined in the Higher Education Act:

1. they must hold the qualifications defined in the Act,
2. they must exercise full legal capacity,
3. they have not been convicted for a premeditated offence, 4. they possess full public rights.
