The competition is open to individuals who meet the requirements specified in Article 113 of the Law on Higher Education and Science of 20 July 2018 (Journal of Laws of 2021, item 478, i.e. Article 113 as amended) and who meet the following requirements:

1. MA in Polish Studies, PhD in Humanities in the field of linguistics;

2. Proven scientific, teaching and organisational achievements in research institutes and/or higher education.

In justified situations, the committee reserves the right to request additional external reviews of the candidates' achievements and/or additional documents to assess the candidates' qualifications.

The competition is open to persons with a master's degree in Polish philology, who hold a doctoral degree in linguistics, specialising in both synchronic and diachronic linguistics and in related areas, such as editing, anthropology of language, rhetoric and language policy. Research and teaching qualifications will be assessed by the committee in proportion to the length of their professional experience, thus ensuring equal opportunities for candidates with recent PhDs and those who have already held academic posts. Evaluation will not be adversely affected by any possible interruptions in academic activity.

# VII) Eligibility criteria

- 1. Number and quality of scholarly publications to date.
- 2. Research experience: internships and scholarships, participation in research projects, queries, etc.
- 3. Teaching experience: innovative methods of working with students, readiness to take on new teaching challenges and to conduct classes and lectures in accordance with the didactic needs of the courses offered at the Faculty of Polish and Classical Philology.
- 4. Organisational experience: organisation of scientific and non-scientific events, working in teams, cooperation with the external environment.
- 5. Research plans and perspectives: internationalisation of research, intended grant applications, research projects, publications (also in languages other than Polish).

## VIII) The selection process

- Competition committee begins working no later than 14 days after the deadline for submission of documents.
- 2. Formal evaluation of submitted proposals.
- 3. Call to provide additional or missing documents if necessary.
- 4. Selection of candidates for the interview stage.
- 5. Interviews for selected candidates who meet the formal requirements.
- 6. The committee has the right to request external reviews of candidates' work or to ask candidates to conduct teaching assignments with an opportunity for student evaluation.
- 7. The chair of the competition committee announces the results and informs the candidates. This information will include justification with a reference to candidates' strengths and weaknesses. Submitted documents will be sent back to candidates.

## IX) Prospects for professional development

Employment in one of the best Polish Studies research and didactic centers is an optimal path of development for a young scholar. An assistant professor is in constant contact with all research and didactic employees at the Faculty of Polish and Classical Philology, participates in the academic life of the Faculty, Institute and Departments. The employee has a possibility to work in research teams and consult the progress of their own research at scientific meetings and conferences organized at the Institute of Polish Philology. The assistant professor can be supported with the preparation and administration of research grant projects, may apply for funding or co-funding of their own research publications and participation in domestic as well as international conferences. They may also undertake research initiatives on their own and organize scientific conferences.

The newly employed assistant professor will have the opportunity to receive a post-doctoral degree and become a professor. All together: research, teaching and organizational work at the Institute of Polish Philology enable to get the necessary competencies, achievements, experience and authority to begin making efforts to obtain the title of professor. The post-doctoral degree (habilitation) procedure is fully financed by the Faculty of Polish and Classical Philology.
