

Competition for the position: ASSISTANT PROFESSOR

Rector-Commandant of the General Tadeusz Kościuszko Military University of Land Forces (MULF) announces a competition for position of Assistant Professor at the Faculty of Management, MULF, in the group of research and teaching employees.

Job status: 1 time - employment contract.

Place of work: The General Tadeusz Kościuszko Military University of Land Forces, ul. Piotra Czajkowskiego 109, Wrocław, Poland.

Main duties will include:

- conducting classes with training groups in accordance with the adopted standards, curricula, study plan and timetable within the teaching load defined in a resolution of the Senate;
- participating in various forms of education and preparing and completing credits and consultations;
- participation in preparing and conducting diploma examinations;
- cooperation with other faculty members in developing and updating study plans and curricula for the courses taught;
- improving didactic and methodical qualifications;
- participation in research teams and conducting scientific and research work;
- participation in seminars, symposia and scientific conferences organized by military and civil universities;
- conducting journalistic activities (textbooks, scripts, methodological studies, articles, etc.)
- participating in the work of committees established at the level of the University to secure its activities;
- participation in the work of committees and in the process of recruitment to the University;
- preparing and maintaining the required didactic and methodical documentation in accordance with the applicable standards;
- performing other duties resulting from the instructions of superiors, substantially related to the position held.

Requirements related to the job that must be met:

- possession of a doctoral degree in the discipline of management and quality sciences or in economics and finance discipline;
- scientific and journalistic achievements in the field of social sciences in the discipline of management and quality science discipline or economics and finance discipline;
- teaching experience in subjects: Project Management, Operations Research, Forecasting under Uncertainty, Statistics or related subjects;
- availability, communication skills, responsibility and independence;
- declaration of participation in scientific and organizational projects carried out by AWL.
- security clearance authorizing access to classified information with minimum clause STRENGTHENED, and in case he/she does not have it, consent to undergo a screening procedure in this regard and submit a Personal Security Questionnaire on the day of

- employment at AWL, in accordance with the Law on Protection of Classified Information of 5 August 2010 (Journal of Laws of 2019, item 742),
- The candidate, who was selected in the recruitment process, makes a statement that during the employment he/she undertakes to inform the employer in writing each time about:
- intention to go and stay abroad,
- the name of the employer where he/she performs paid work and the address of its registered office.

Additional competences:

- commitment and creativity, determining the attractive course of classes;
- professional practice connected with teaching;
- ability to work in task teams.

- in the case of candidacy of foreigners whose documents are not issued in Polish, it is necessary to submit copies of the documents together with a sworn translation;
- if the academic degree was obtained at a foreign university, a copy of the document confirming the nostrification of the title / academic title should be submitted (if required by law) or a statement as to the basis for the recognition of the title / degree on the basis of the agreement on recognition of equivalent education in Poland;
- a declaration is required for candidates who are not Polish citizens about undergoing the examination procedure.

The above documents should be delivered to MULF in a sealed envelope with the name of the position.

Please add the following clause: *"I have read the content of the information clause, including information about the purpose and methods of processing my personal data and my rights"*

The University reserves the right to contact selected persons who meet the requirements specified in the announcement and to cancel the Competition without giving reasons.
