Requirements:

- habilitation degree in the field of humanities, preferably in the discipline of culture and religion studies or similar,
- scientific achievements in the scope of research carried out at the Faculty of Humanities, especially dealing with research on the cultural dimension of technology, proved by at least one cycle of publication in scientific journals or scientific books, or chapters in scientific book, included in scientific evaluation,
- active participation in local and international scientific conferences,
- important scientific activities in collaboration with other universities or research institution, especially international ones,
- experience in research projects (managing research projects or scientific teams or conducting tasks as a team member),
- dedication of 100% of one's research time in the discipline of culture and religion studies,
- experience in academic level teaching, including lectures and seminars,
- documented knowledge of the English language at least B2 level (candidates who are not Polish citizens should show a certificate of proficiency of the Polish language at C1 level or higher),
- candidates that managed scientific teams in research projects, can document their solid scholarly achievements, educational or professional experience in IT will be preferred for this vacancy.

The candidate must fulfil the following requirements defined in the Polish Law on Higher Education:

- possesses qualifications defined in the Law,
- has full legal capacity,
- has not been punished by final court judgement for intentional offence,
- enjoys full public rights.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

1. Letter of application, CV, personal questionnaire,
2. Copies of diplomas and other certificates confirming the qualifications possessed,

3. Statement of the English language proficiency,
4. List of publications, research projects, conferences, training sessions, internships and classes taught,
5. Declaration stating that the AGH University of Science and Technology is going to be the main place of employment of the candidate,
6. A short research proposal - a short description of a research project (from 3 to 5 pages) (including the research problem, objectives, research methods and their expected results), which can be submitted by the candidate in the form of a grant application and implemented as part of future employment at WH AGH.
