DESCRIPTION (field, expectations, comments, requirements):

The Faculty of Physics and Applied Computer Science at AGH University of Science and Technology in Krakow, Poland has an opening for a research and teaching assistant position in the Department of Condensed Matter Physics. The selected candidate is expected to join a project related to the LHCb experiment that entered its Run 3 data taking stage after a deep upgrade. The candidate will take responsibility for rare hadronic decays analysis related to the CKM matrix angle gamma measurement. We require the candidate to have an extensive knowledge of advanced statistical data analysis, very good knowledge of the Root framework, proficient knowledge of Python and C++ programming languages as well as advanced techniques of intelligent data analysis.

Requirements:

- has at least a MSc degree or equivalent, obtained in the field of "technical physics" or similar,
- participation in the PHD program and open doctoral thesis or a doctoral student at a doctoral school after a positive mid-term evaluation and completed modules preparing for work as an academic teacher provided for in the doctoral school education program or has initiated proceedings to award a doctoral degree,
- has scientific achievements in the field of experimental high energy physics, confirmed by publications and talks at national and international scientific conferences,
- can proficiently program in Python and C++, knows Root analysis framework,
- has experience in analysis of data collected by a large high energy physics experiment (preferably operating at LHC collider @CERN),
- has experience in teaching,
- has substantive preparation and is ready to conduct classes in the form of computer laboratories in the field of computational intelligence,
- knows English at a level of at least B-2,
- proven knowledge of the Polish language at the C1 level, if it is not the mother tongue.

1. Application and CV with a personal questionnaire,
2. 1 recommendation letter,
3. certificate of minimum B-2 language skills,
4. copy of diplomas or other certificates confirming the qualifications held.
