



<u>Competition for the position</u> of the adjunct at the Faculty of Management, MULF

Rector-Commandant of the General Tadeusz Kościuszko Military University of Land Forces (MULF) announces a competition for position of Assistant Professor at the Faculty of Management, MULF, in the group of researching and teaching employees.

Job status: 1 time - employment contract- employment starting October 2022.

<u>Place of work:</u> The General Tadeusz Kościuszko Military University of Land Forces, ul. Piotra Czajkowskiego 109, Wrocław, Poland.

Main duties will include:

- conducting classes with training groups in accordance with the study plan, curriculum and timetable within the teaching load defined in the Senate's resolution;
- participation in various forms of education and preparation and realization of credits and consultations;
- collaborating with other faculty members in developing and updating study plans and curricula for the subjects taught at the Faculty of Management;
- improving didactic and methodical qualifications;
- participation in research teams and conducting scientific and research work;
- participation in seminars, symposia and scientific conferences organized by military and civilian universities;
- Participation in the work of committees established at the level of the University to secure its activities;
- conducting journalistic activities (textbooks, scripts, methodological studies, articles, etc.)
- preparing and maintaining the required didactic and methodical documentation in accordance with the applicable standards;
- Performing other duties resulting from the orders of superiors, related to the substantive position held.

Requirements related to the job that must be met:

- possession of a doctoral degree in the field of engineering sciences in the discipline of technical informatics and telecommunications, or in the field of science and natural sciences in the discipline of computer science, or in the field of technical sciences in the discipline of computer science or related disciplines;
- scientific and journalistic achievements in the field of technical sciences, engineering and technical sciences or sciences and natural sciences;
- significant scientific and teaching achievements;
- fluency in the Polish language;
- the candidate, who was selected in the recruitment process, makes a statement that during the employment he/she undertakes to inform the employer in writing each time about:

-intention to go and stay abroad,

- the name of the employer where he/she performs paid work and the address of its registered office.



- english teaching experience (candidate's declaration);
- commitment and creativity, conditioning an attractive course of classes;
- availability, communication, responsibility and independence;
- apprenticeship related to conducting classes;
- ability to work in task teams.

Documents: CV, cover letter, copies of documents confirming: education, work experience, completion of courses and training and other documents confirming qualifications, declaration of full-time employment at MULF, a statement that it meets the requirements referred to in art. 20 clause 1 points 1-3 and art. 276 paragraph 1 points 7 and 8 of the Act of 20 July Law on Higher Education and Science, in the case of candidacy of foreigners whose documents are not issued in Polish, it is necessary to submit copies of the document together with a sworn translation; if the work title was obtained at a foreign university, a copy of the document confirming the nostrification of the title / academic title should be submitted (if required by law) or a statement as to the basis for the recognition of the title / degree on the basis of the agreement on recognition of equivalent education in Poland; a declaration is required for candidates who are not Polish citizens about undergoing the examination procedure.

The above documents should be delivered to MULF in a sealed envelope with the name of the position.
