The project Weave-UNISONO: "Specific pathomechanisms of aging-related endothelial dysfunction in sepsis: investigation of mechanisms and experimental therapy Prof. dr hab. S. Chłopicki

The competitive selection process is open for all individuals, who meet the requirements set out in Articles 113 and 116.2.3) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science, and who meet the following eligibility criteria according to § 165 of the Statute of the Jagiellonian University:

- 1) Holding at least a doctoral degree in the field of biomedical, medical, pharmaceutical chemical, or related;
- 2) Having relevant scientific achievements;
- 3) Taking active part in scientific life;

additional requirements:

- 4) experience in interdisciplinary in vivo/ex vivo pharmacological studies.
- 5) experience in measuring endothelial function in vivo, ex vivo, vascular biology, in vitro endothelial studies.
- 6) demonstrated experience in working with animals.
- 7) experience and knowledge in: assessment of aging changes, fluorescence microscopy measurements, molecular microscopy and biochemical analysis; sample preparation; histological, immunohistochemical and immunofluorescence stainings.
- 6) active participation in science manifested in particular by participation in foreign and domestic scientific conferences;
- 7) scientific achievements in the form of publications, trainings, participation in research projects;
- 8) experience in laboratory work,
- 9) fluency in spoken and written English;
- 10) experience and passion for scientific work.

The tasks of an employed person will include:

- participation in realization of the Weave UNISONO project financed by the National Science Centre Poland
- 2) designing, preparing and conducting experiments as part of the project:
- 3) assessment of endothelial function and permeability changes, assessment of senescence changes, performing fluorescent microscopy measurements, performing molecular and biochemical analyses; samples preparation; performing histological, immunohistochemical and immunofluorescent stainings;
- 4) data integration, statistical analysis and the analysis and description of research results;
- 5) the design, preparation and conduction of experiments, providing help in in vivo/ ex vivo experiments on small laboratory animals (rats, mouse);
- 6) preparation of periodic reports;
- 7) preparation of scientific publications, presenting the results of research;
- 8) active participation in international scientific conferences;
- 9) active co-operation with JCET teams
- 10) taking care of the entrusted laboratory equipment.
