#### II) Job Offer description

The post-doc is expected to be an expert in literary studies especially in the Polish novel of the 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> centuries. He would join the international consortium studying political novel in Europe in 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> centuries (Horizon Europe Grant). The researcher would prepare his own papers for the consortium and participate in its meetings. He would be expected to arrange conferences and workshops of the Poznań group belonging to the consortium. The post-doc would place documents and files of the consortium members on the special grant's Internet platform. The researcher would help in contacts with consortium members from

foreign countries and with the members of the Global Advisory Board supporting the consortium.

The competition is open to individuals who meet the requirements specified in Article 113 of the Law on Higher Education and Science of 20 July 2018 (Journal of Laws of 2022, item 574, i.e. Article 113 as amended) and who meet the following requirements:

3. Papers concerning theory of literature, poetics and philosophy of literature.
4. Translations into Polish of the literary studies' papers.

## **VII) Eligibility criteria**

7. Participation in scientific conferences and organization of scientific conferences.
8. Research internships abroad.
9. Knowledge of websites administration rules.

## **VIII) The selection process**

1. Competition committee begins working no later than 14 days after the deadline for submission of documents.
2. Formal evaluation of submitted proposals.
3. Call to provide additional or missing documents if necessary.
4. Selection of candidates for the interview stage.
5. Interviews for candidates who meet the formal requirements.
6. The committee has the right to request external reviews of candidates' work or to ask candidates to conduct teaching assignments with an opportunity for student evaluation.
7. The chair of the competition committee announces the results and informs the candidates. This information will include justification with a reference to candidates' strengths and weaknesses. Submitted documents will be sent back to candidates.

## **IX) Prospects for professional development**

The work will enable publication of the research results on the consortium's website and in monographs published in the most prestigious foreign scientific publishing houses. The work will ensure activity in the international scientific community composed of outstanding literary scholars from many European countries. The result of the work will be scientific development, expanding knowledge about European literatures, expanding knowledge of the latest literary research methodologies used in Europe and around the world. Prestigious publications and obtained experiences will significantly increase the chances during competitions for the position of the assistant professor in scientific institutions in Poland and abroad.
