DESCRIPTION (field, expectations, comments, requirements):

The Faculty of Physics and Applied Computer Science at AGH University of Science and Technology in Krakow, Poland has an opening for a research assistant professor in the Department of Applied Informatics and Computational Physics. The selected candidate is expected to join a project on solving multicriteria optimization methods using nature-inspired algorithms.

The project is a part of the Initiative for Excellence – Research University AGH, activity #11: Financing short-term visits of scientists from abroad, as well as grants for long-term stays of foreign scientists at AGH.

Requirements:

- a doctoral degree in the discipline of "information and communication technology" or in a related discipline,
- knowledge of optimization issues with methods inspired by nature, including multi-criteria optimization - confirmed by scientific publications in this field,
- significant scientific achievements in the field of artificial intelligence confirmed by publications in journals from the Journal Citation Reports list (minimum 10 papers published in the 2 years preceding the year of the competition announcement),
- significant contribution to the development of the field of artificial intelligence confirmed by bibliometric indicators (H index above 15 according to Web of Science),
- completed a postdoctoral fellowship at a foreign institution for at least 1 year,
- active participation in scientific conferences and symposiums,
- organizational achievements,
- knowledge of the English language at least at C-1 level.

The candidate must fulfil the following requirements defined in the Polish Law on Higher Education:

- possesses qualifications defined in the Law,
- has full legal capacity,
- has not been punished by final court judgement for intentional offence,
- enjoys full public rights.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

When submitting the application the following documents must be provided:

1. motivation letter, CV, personal questionnaire,
2. a copy of diplomas or other certificates confirming the qualifications held,
3. list of scientific achievements (list of publications: books, articles, papers published in conference materials, etc.; list of research and practical studies, patents, etc., completed scientific internships and values of bibliometric indicators based on Web of Science) and organizational (list of full functions in the past and present, at the university or outside the university, etc.),
4. opinion of the PhD supervisor or opinion from the previous place of work or periodic evaluation,
5. a document confirming the knowledge of the language at the level of at least C-1.
