The scope of the main tasks performed at the workplace:

- conducting didactic classes with training groups in accordance with the accepted standards with the curricula, the study plan and the timetable of classes as part of the number of classes specified in the Senate resolution:
- development and maintenance of training documentation;
- participation in seminars, symposia and scientific conferences organized by military and civil universities:
- conducting journalistic activity (textbooks, scripts, methodological studies, articles, etc.);
- preparation of planning and analytical materials and reports on teaching activities;
- analyzing education and training programs in the field of subjects and developing proposals for their changes, taking into account the current needs and conclusions from the audit activity;
- using the elements of the IT system supporting the University management process in the area of planning, recording and settlement of the teaching process as well as document circulation within the scope of its competences.

Requirements to meet related to the job:

- Master's degree (or equivalent), post-graduate course completed;
- Internship as a lecturer or significant professional achievements (experience).
- Author or co-author of publications (scripts, manuals and other professional studies)
- Coaching qualifications in a minimum of one martial arts discipline (such as: boxing, judo, karate, wrestling);
- Shooting instructor's license;
- •Qualification to carry out shooting from: pneumatic, rimfire and centerfire firearms, semi and automatic plus smoothbore firearms;
- To have the ability to use elements of the IT system supporting the University management process in the area of planning, recording and settlement of the teaching process, as well as document circulation within the scope of their competences;
- To have the ability to conduct Close Combat classes implemented in the national defense ministry
- Knowledge of the weapons used in the Polish Armed Forces;
