II) Job Offer description

Institute of Oriental Studies at Adam Mickiewicz University (Poznań, Poland) seeks to appoint an assistant professor (*Pol. adiunkt*) specialising in Chinese literature.

We are looking for a researcher in the field of Chinese literary studies with documented achievements, highly motivated to didactic work, with content knowledge in Chinese literature teaching and experience in teaching Chinese as a foreign language. The selected candidate will be expected to teach Chinese to university students of the 1st and 2nd cycle (as defined within the framework of the Bologna Process). The teaching workload will be 210 hrs per academic year.

III) Requirments and qualifications

The competition is open to individuals who meet the requirements specified in Article 113 of the Law on Higher Education and Science of 20 July 2018 (Journal of Laws of 2022, item 574, i.e. Article 113 as amended) and who meet the following requirements:

- 1. doctoral degree in literary studies (Chinese literature studies)
- 2. academic achievements in the form of publications in the field of Chinese literary studies, participation in conferences

3. ability of presenting the prospect of researches leading to habilitation

4. at least several years of documented experience in teaching (Chinese language didactics)

5. very good substantive preparation for teaching the history of Chinese literature

6. very good knowledge of spoken and written Chinese (Mandarin), very good knowledge of English

7. an additional advantage will be readiness to teach Chinese culture

VIII) The selection process

- 5. Interviews for candidates who meet the formal requirements.

- 7. The chair of the competition committee announces the results and informs the candidates. This information will include justification with a reference to candidates' strengths and weaknesses. Submitted documents will be sent back to candidates.
